

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Who can attend the concerts?

Anyone who buys a ticket is welcome to join us for the concerts!

Do I need tickets?

Yes. Tickets are available for purchase on our website at <u>www.fordhouse.org</u>, or at our Visitors Center. Tickets can be purchased until the night of the concert unless the concert sells out.

What is included with Premium and General seating?

Premium seating gives you a folding chair and closer access to the stage and general seating includes lawn seating.

What Can I bring?

Folding camp chairs, low to the ground chairs, and blankets are allowed. Tents and large tables are not allowed. Limited preferred seating is available for purchase as well.

Can I bring in my own food?

You may bring in food and non-alcoholic drinks. Coolers are welcome too. No outside alcohol, please. You are also welcome to stop by *The Speedster* in the Visitor Center to pick up meals, snacks, and drinks.

Can I arrive early, set up my chair, and then go grab food from the Speedster in the Visitor Center prior to the concert start time?

Gates open at 5 pm. Yes, you are more than welcome to. Please note that Ford House is not responsible for any personal belongings left unattended.

Where can I park?

Any open parking spot. Parking is free to concert-goers.

Is there handicap parking?

Yes, marked handicap parking is available.

How do I get from the parking lot to the house?

Guests are welcome to walk to the house. We will also have shuttles available to transport to the house as well.

Can I bring the kids?

Yes. However, young children must stay with you at all times and are not allowed to roam.

Can I bring a dog?

While Ford House loves dogs, we ask that you leave them home for the evening.

Is there a public restroom?

Yes. There will be portable restrooms available outside.

What is the weather policy?

All shows are weather permitting. If the forecast for the day shows a steady rain in the forecast, the show will be postponed. Each concert has a rain date listed on the website. Postponements will be posted on our social media and our website. Our goal is to announce cancellations due to weather 4 hours prior to showtime.
